**Respect for others:** Maintaining pace shows courtesy to fellow members, visitors, and staff who help keep the course running smoothly.

### **Ready Golf – Playing Smart & Efficiently**

To help maintain a consistent pace, we strongly encourage the adoption of **Ready Golf** in all non-Matchplay formats. This simply means playing when it's safe and

sensible to do so, rather than always waiting for "the honour" or "furthest from the hole."

Here are a few key reminders:

**Shorter hitters** should play first when it's safe.

**Play when ready**, not strictly in turn.

**Hit your shot before helping** search for a lost ball (unless you're much closer to the hole).

**Putt out when practical**, rather than marking short putts unnecessarily.

**Be prepared** — select your club, line up, and complete pre-shot routines promptly.

**Play a provisional ball immediately** if there's any chance your original is lost or out of bounds.

**Position trolleys, carts, and bags** for a quick move to the next tee.

**Leave the green promptly** and **mark scorecards** on the next tee.
